



## PATIENT INFORMATION SHEET

### 4 DAYS PRIOR TO SURGERY:

- Go to your scheduled location for COVID-19 testing. Follow the signs/instructions in the parking lot for where to go. You may not need to leave your car. After your testing go directly home and continue to self-isolate.
- Following CDC guidelines for elective surgery, please begin to self-isolate immediately following your COVID-19 test to prevent exposure to COVID-19. Continue to self-isolate until you come in for surgery.
- During self-isolation it is expected that you STAY HOME and do not expose yourself to anyone outside of your household. Please avoid all public places including, but not limited to, work, hotels, public transportation, gas stations, bars/restaurants, grocery stores, and pharmacies.
- Your family members may leave the home to go to work or run any necessary errands, though we encourage them to stay home and only leave when absolutely necessary. If your family members do leave the house, please ensure they are following CDC guidelines while out of the home and follow proper hand hygiene guidelines upon returning home.
- This helps limit opportunities to come in contact with contaminated surfaces and infected people outside your home.

### DAY BEFORE SURGERY:

- You should be expecting a phone call the day prior to your surgery with your surgery start time and arrival time. You will be asked COVID-19 screening questions during this phone call.

### DAY OF SURGERY

- Prior to entering the OSMS/BOSC building please put on a mask. If you do not have a mask at home one will be provided to you when you enter the building. Enter the front doors and turn left. Take the elevator up to the second floor and follow the signs. Your temperature will be taken by a staff member and you will be asked COVID-19 screening questions.

### VISITOR POLICY:

- BOSC currently has a NO visitor policy in place. You will need a responsible adult to drop you off and pick you up from surgery, however they will not be able to enter the building with you. We ask that while they are waiting for your surgery to be completed that they do not go shopping. If they need to use the restroom they can enter the OSMS/BOSC building and use the restroom after passing the COVID-19 screening questions and putting on a mask.
